<p>Required Documents</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Curriculum vitae (<a href="#">designated format available</a>) Include educational background (from high school onward), employment history, awards/punishments, honors, and email address.</li> <li>2) List of research achievements Categorize into: (i) Peer-reviewed journal articles, (ii) Review articles, (iii) Books, (iv) Patents Indicate the number of citations for academic papers and specify the citation database used (e.g., Google Scholar Citations, Scopus, Inspire).</li> <li>3) Up to three major original publications.</li> <li>4) List of research funding (All the funds are classified by the funding system. Name of research funding and organization, title of the research project, research period, name of principal investigator, total budget, and budget provided for the applicant are listed clearly).</li> <li>5) Summary of past research activities and future research plane (up to A4 two pages).</li> <li>6) List of two references with his/her names, affiliations, positions, telephone numbers, and e-mail addresses.</li> </ol>
